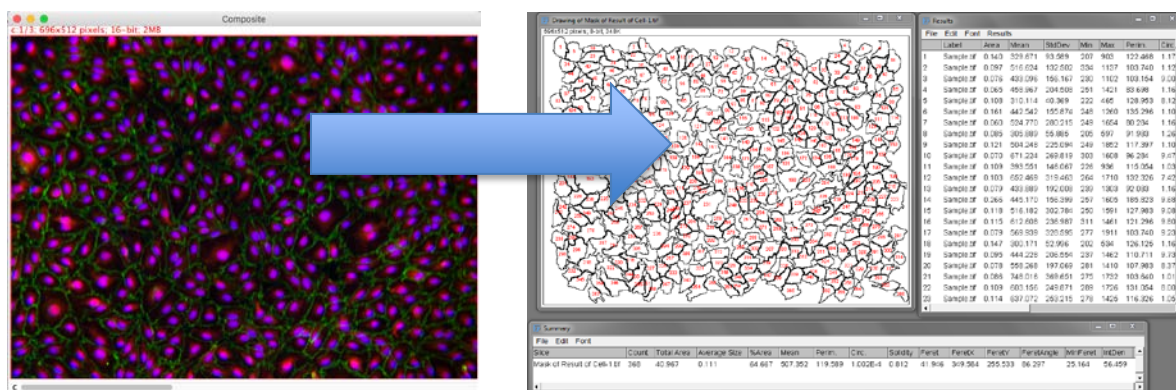


# FIJI/ImageJ Workshop
